ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Exemption from regulation 7 (1) of Cap. 43:11 (Sub. Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Investment, Trade and Industry by section 38 as read with section 42 (2) (g) of the Liquor Act, the following regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Liquor (Exemption) (No. 6) Regulations, 2020. Citation
2. David Kealeboga Nankonana t/a Dikampa General Dealer and Fresh Produce, operating in Rakhuna Village, is exempt from regulation 7 (1) of the Liquor Regulations, which requires proposed business premises to be at least 500 meters away from a school, highway, major road or church. Exemption from regulation 7 (1) of Cap.43:11 (Sub. Leg.)
