ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation
2. Grant of ways of necessity

IN EXERCISE of powers conferred on the Minister of Transport and Public Works by section 4 of the Public Roads Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Roads (Grant of Ways of Necessity) Order, 2023. Citation

2. (1) The ways of roads of necessity described in the Schedule hereto are granted as ways or roads of necessity. Grant of ways of necessity

(2) The width and direction of each way or road of necessity under subparagraph (1) shall be as appears in the drawings deposited by the applicant with the Director of Surveys and Lands.

SCHEDULE

The Minister grants authority to —

- SRR Engineer (Pty) Ltd for the proposed all movement access into proposed police station and staff housing, Lot 9816 along A14 road in Letlhakane as per submission referenced SRR/RD/LP/KS/001, dated 3rd May, 2023 and drawing No. LPS-SRR-/2017/1020 Rev D by Ministry of Transport and Public Works; and
- Engiconsult (Pty) Ltd for a proposed all movement access into a proposed commercial development Lot 1717 along A3 road in Mathangwane as per submission referenced EC/RD?MATHS-01 dated 14th April, 2023 and drawing No. EC/MATHS2022/300, Rev. by Far Property Company (Pty) Ltd.
