ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation
2. Grant of ways of necessity

IN EXERCISE of powers conferred on the Minister of Transport and Public Works by section 4 of the Public Roads Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Roads (Grant of Ways of Necessity) Order, 2024. Citation

2. (1) The ways of roads of necessity described in the Schedule hereto are granted as ways or roads of necessity. Grant of ways of necessity

(2) The width and direction of each way or road of necessity under subparagraph (1) shall be as appears in the drawings deposited by the applicants with the Director of Surveys and Lands.

SCHEDULE

The Minister grants authority to —

- (a) Botswana Fibre Network (BOFINET) for a proposed road reserve occupation for the provision of underground fibre optic cables to various Botswana Police Service cameras around greater Gaborone area along A1, A10, A12 and A129 roads as per submission referenced POL.12/10/1 IV (102) dated 31st August, 2023 for Botswana Police Service;
- (b) Botswana Power Corporation for a proposed road reserve occupation for the provision of underground power cables to various Botswana Police Service city cameras around greater Gaborone area along A1, A10, A12 and A129 roads as per submission referenced POL.12/10/1 IV (102) dated 31st August, 2023 for Botswana Police Service; and
- (c) Pinagare Engineers (Pty) Ltd for all movement access at grade intersection with bituminous surfacing, turning and auxiliary lanes with sufficient drainage facility of the road for Government petroleum reserve storage depot along A2 road in Ghanzi for Botswana Oil Limited as per submission dated 11th April, 2022 and drawings No. BOL/GHANZI/203, REV 01.
