(Published on 16th May, 2025)

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation
2. Grant of ways of necessity

IN EXERCISE of powers conferred on the Minister of Transport and Infrastructure by section 4 of the Public Roads Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Public Roads (Grant of Ways of Necessity) Order, 2025. Citation

2. (1) The ways of roads of necessity described in the Schedule hereto are granted as ways or roads of necessity. Grant of ways of necessity

(2) The width and direction of each way or road of necessity under subparagraph (1) shall be as appears in the drawings deposited by the applicant with the Director of Surveys and Lands.

SCHEDULE

The Minister grants authority to —

- (a) Aceteam (Pty) Ltd for a proposed road access: all movement junction along Lentsweletau – Metsimotlhabe Road into a proposed filling station into a Tribal Lot No. 9788 in Lentsweletau as per submission referenced: AC010/24 dated 21st October, 2024 and Junction's drawing No. LTL-001-24 Rev P1 dated September, 2024 for Gaone Phiri;
- (b) Botswana Fibre Network (Pty) Ltd for A proposed reserve occupation by Aerial Fibre Optic Cable (5.65km) along B300 Road and one (1) underground road crossing at [A14 road], at Orapa, submission dated 21st January, 2025, ref: BOFINET 18/1/2/6 Vol I (22) and drawings No: BOF/ORAPA/2025(1) dated 20th January, 2025 Rev 0, BOF/ORAPA/2025(2) dated 16th January, 2025 Rev 1, and BOF/ORAPA/2025(3) dated 17th January, 2025 Rev 0. The developer must do underground crossing for the proposed road crossing for Botswana Fibre Network (Pty) Ltd;
- (c) China Geo/Ion Exchange Safic / SAMAB JV for a proposed reserve occupation by a 24km water pipeline from Ikongwe to Kodibeleng, including one underground road crossing on the Scrowe/Shoshong road at Ikongwe and a 16km Water Pipeline from Moralane to Mosolotshane, with two road crossings at Moralane and one underground road crossing at Mosolotshane, submission dated 17th January, 2025, Ref: CGIOSS JV/20250114/027 and Drawings No: Top-01/2025 to Top-18/2025 Rev 2 dated January, 2025 for Water Utilities Corporation;
- (d) Donya Digital (Pty) Ltd T/A Universal Wifi for the proposed reserve occupation for the installation of 850 meters of overhead Fibre optic cable along the A1 Road (Western Bypass)

from Block 8 circle to Block 7 turn-off. The project also includes two underground road crossings on the A1 Road – one near Block 7 turn-off and another opposite Westgate Mall. The recommendation is based on submission reference 001/2025/UNI-MIN dated 27th January, 2025, along with drawings No. UNI00124, UNI00125, and UNI00126 (revised on 10th January, 2025) for Donya Digital (Pty) Ltd t/a Universal Wifi;

- (e) Keifab Engineers (Pty) Ltd for a proposed road access: all movement junction along Sefophe – Martins drift road into a proposed filling station into a proposed truck stop and fuel depot on Bamangwato Tribal Territory CA 447, Lerala, Botswana. Recommendation is based on submission referenced: MC/M&A/LM/18.02.25 dated 18th February, 2025 and drawings No. 601 Revision 1 dated June, 2024 for Los Diesel; and
- (f) Webex Holdings (Pty) Ltd for the proposed reserve occupation for the installation of pipeline along the A3 road (Phuduhudu – Motopi). The project also includes one underground road crossing on the A3 road near Phuduhudu village. The recommendation is based on the letter referenced L02/2025.2.25/SP, dated 4th March, 2025, along with the following drawings: No. 001 (Revision 1) dated March 2025, No. CSP001 (Revision 1) dated February, 2025, ad No. CS01A (Revision 1) dated February, 2025 for Water Utilities Corporation.
