AN ACT TO AMEND THE CITIZENSHIP OF BOTSWANA (SUPPLEMENTARY PROVISIONS) LAW, 1966

Date of Assent: 21.2.68.

Date of Commencement: 23.3.68.

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Citizenship of Botswana (Supplementary Provisions) (Amendment) Act, 1968.

Amendment of Section 7 of Law 39 of 1966

2. Section 7 of the Citizenship of Botswana (Supplementary Provisions) Law, 1966, is amended —

(a) in subsection (1) by the insertion, prior to "ordinarily resident" wherever this appears of "lawfully";

(b) by the addition of the following subsection —

"(4) For the purposes of this section a person shall be deemed to have been lawfully ordinarily resident in Botswana during any period in which he is deemed to have been lawfully ordinarily resident in Botswana for the purposes of section 3 of the Immigration (Consolidation) Law, 1966 (No. 19 of 1966)."

Addition of Section 19 of Law 39 of 1966

3. The principal law is amended by the insertion after section 18 of the following section —

“Extension of Period in Which a Person may Make Renunciation of Citizenship

19. The Minister may by order in the *Gazette* extend beyond the specified date as defined in section 29 (6) of the Constitution, the period in which any person may make a renunciation of citizenship, take an oath or make a declaration for the purposes of section 29 of the Constitution.”.
