AN ACT TO AMEND THE DIPLOMATIC IMMUNITIES AND PRIVILEGES PROCLAMATION (CHAPTER 42)

Date of Assent: 1.5.68

Date of Commencement: 3.5.68

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Diplomatic Immunities and Privileges (Amendment) Act, 1968.

Amendment of Section 11 of Cap. 42

2. Section 11 of the Diplomatic Immunities and Privileges Proclamation is amended –

(a) in paragraph (b) of subsection (1) by

- (i) the insertion after “representatives of” of “or contractors to”;
- (ii) the deletion of “mentioned” and the substitution of “specified”;

(b) in subsection (3) by the insertion after “representative of” of “or contractor to”.

(c) by the addition of the following subsection –

“(6) In this section “contractor” includes any specified employee of a contractor.”.
