AN ACT TO AMEND THE EXPLOSIVES LAW

Date of Assent: 1.5.68

Date of Commencement: 3.5.68

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Explosives (Amendment) Act, 1968.

Amendment of Section 2 of Law No. 31 of 1961

2. The Explosives Law, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the principal law) is amended in section 2 by the insertion of the following definition —

“ “military” includes that which pertains to any armed force (including a police force), whether such force is of a regular or irregular character;”.

Amendment of Section 4 of Law No. 31 of 1961

3. Section 4 of the principal law is amended in subsection (2) by the deletion of “imprisonment.” at the end thereof and the substitution of “imprisonment, save that where the offence relates to the importation of explosives intended or adapted for military use, no such penalty shall exceed imprisonment for a period of four years.”.
