AN ACT TO MAKE TEMPORARY PROVISION CONCERNING THE RAILWAYS

Date of Assent: 1.5.68

Date of Commencement: 3.5.68

ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

Short Title

1. This Act may be cited as the Railways (Adaptation of Statutory Provisions) Act, 1968.

Provision for Giving Effect to New Arrangements Concerning Railways

2. The President may, by Order published in the *Gazette*, make such provision (whether by amendment to the Railways Proclamation (Cap. 163) or otherwise) as may appear to him to be necessary or expedient for giving effect or enabling effect to be given in Botswana to new arrangements affecting the administration, operation or ownership of the railways.

Duration of Provision

3. Any Order made in pursuance of section 2 shall, unless it is otherwise provided by law, cease to have effect on the 31st December, 1969.
