THE FAUNA CONSERVATION (GENERAL) (AMENDMENT)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 93(2) of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961, (No. 22 of 1961) the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs hereby makes the following Regulations —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (General) (Amendment) Regulations, 1968.


