**THE FAUNA CONSERVATION PROCLAMATION, 1961**

**THE FAUNA CONSERVATION (LAKE NGAMI CONTROLLED HUNTING AREA)  
REGULATIONS, 1968**

(Published on 11th April, 1968)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 11 as read with section 93 of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961 (Proclamation No. 22 of 1961), the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs hereby makes the following regulations —

**Title and Application**

1. (1) These regulations may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (Lake Ngami Controlled Hunting Area) Regulations, 1968.

(2) The provisions of these regulations shall not apply to any person who is ordinarily resident in Botswana.

**Interpretation**

2. (1) In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires —

“controlled hunting area” means the Lake Ngami Controlled Hunting Area declared as such under the provisions of Statutory Instrument No. 27 of 1968;

“game bird” means a bird listed in Part A of the Third Schedule to the Proclamation;

“guide” means guide approved by the licensing officer;

“licensing officer” means the Game Warden, Maun;

“permit” means permit issued under these regulations.

**Hunting by Other Persons in the Controlled Hunting Area**

3. (1) No person to whom these regulations apply shall hunt any animal within the controlled hunting area other than a game bird.

(2) No person to whom these regulations apply shall hunt any game bird within the controlled hunting area unless he is —

(a) in possession of a bird licence issued under the Proclamation; and

(b) he is in possession of a permit issued under the provisions of regulation 4 authorizing the hunting of such bird in that controlled hunting area.

**Permits to Hunt in Controlled Hunting Areas**

4. (1) A permit to hunt in a controlled hunting area shall be issued by the licensing officer and shall be in the form prescribed in the Schedule.

(2) A permit shall not be issued save —

(a) on production of a valid bird licence issued under the provisions of the Proclamation; and

(b) on payment of a fee of R2 for each day for which the licence is granted;

(c) on payment of such sum of money as may be required under the provisions of regulation 7.



**Register of Birds to be Kept**

10. The holder of a permit shall, on the same day as any game bird is killed or wounded or before such bird is removed from the controlled hunting area, whichever is the sooner, endorse upon his permit the species and sex of that bird.

**Penalties**

11. Any person to whom these regulations apply who hunts or captures any bird in a controlled hunting area except in accordance with the provisions of these regulations shall be guilty of an offence and liable, on conviction, to the penalties prescribed in section 11 of the Proclamation.

**PERMIT TO HUNT IN LAKE NGAMI CONTROLLED HUNTING AREA**  
 (not transferable)  
 (Regulation 4)

In terms of Regulation 4 of the Fauna Conservation (Lake Ngami Controlled Hunting Area) Regulations, 1968 permission is hereby granted to: ..... of .....

 to hunt game birds not exceeding twenty ducks or geese and not exceeding twenty other game birds daily in the Lake Ngami Controlled Hunting Area during the period from midnight on the ..... (state day of week) and including such day, the ..... of ..  
 ..... 19 .... to midnight on the ..... (state day of week) and including such day, the ..... of ..... 19 .... on payment of a fee of R2-00 (Rand two) per day.

This permit is issued subject to the condition that the holder is in possession of a valid bird licence.

Details of birds killed or wounded must be entered on the register before such birds are removed from the controlled hunting area or on the day on which they are hunted, whichever shall be the sooner.
