**THE FOREST (PROTECTED TREES) NOTICE, 1968**

(Published on 10th May, 1968)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 11 of the Forest Act, 1968 (No. 23 of 1968), the Minister of Agriculture hereby makes the following notice —

**Citation**

1. This notice may be cited as the Forest (Protected Trees) Notice, 1968.

**Declaration of Protected Trees**

2. All trees of the species listed below growing upon State Land within the Chobe District are declared to be protected trees —
