THE FRANCISTOWN GENERAL (AMENDMENT) BYE-LAWS, 1968

(Published on 29th November, 1968)

It is hereby notified that His Excellency the Acting President has in terms of Regulation 32 of the Town Council Regulations, 1966 (L.N. No. 37 of 1966 as amended) approved of the following bye-laws made by the Francistown Town Council under the provisions of section 31 of the aforesaid Regulations --

Citation

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Francistown General (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1968.

Insertion of Bye-law 36A into S.I. No. 41 of 1967

2. The Francistown General Bye-laws, 1967, are amended by the insertion of the following bye-law after bye-law 36 --

"Control of Air Guns and Catapults

36A. (1) No person shall carry or discharge any air rifle, or pistol or catapult in any street or public place.

(2) No person shall discharge any air rifle, or pistol or catapult otherwise than in a street or public place in a manner whereby the projectile so discharged travels into or across, or would be likely to travel into or across, any street or public place."

Amendment of Bye-law 37 of S.I. No. 41 of 1967

3. The principal bye-laws are amended in Bye-law 37 (2) by the deletion of "or 33" and the substitution of, "33 or 36A".
