**THE IMMIGRATION (CONSOLIDATION) LAW, 1966
THE IMMIGRATION (VISA) AMENDMENT REGULATIONS 1968**

(Published on 11th October, 1968)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 31 of the Immigration (Consolidation) Law, 1966 (No. 19 of 1966) His Excellency the Acting President hereby makes the following Regulations —

Citation

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Immigration (Visa) Amendment Regulations, 1968.

Repeal and Substitution of Regulations 6 (2) of Statutory Instrument No. 32 of 1967

2. Regulation 6(2) of the Immigration (Visa) Regulations, 1967 (Statutory Instrument No. 32 of 1967) is hereby repealed and the following substituted

6(2) There shall be payable for a visa a fee of R2.25 or the equivalent thereof in round figures in the currency of the country in which the visa is obtained, being a country in which a Botswana Mission is situated.

Provided that no charge shall be made for visas issued to Nationals of countries which do not charge fees for visas issued to Botswana Nationals.
