**THE LOBATSI GENERAL (AMENDMENT) BYE-LAWS, 1968**

(Published on 24th May, 1968)

It is hereby notified that His Excellency the President has, in terms of regulation 32 of the Town Council Regulations, 1966 (L.N. No. 37 of 1966), approved of the following bye-laws made by the Lobatsi Town Council under the provisions of section 31 of the aforesaid regulations —

**Citation**

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Lobatsi General (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1968.

**Amendment of Bye-law 3(2) of S.I. No. 47 of 1967**

2. Bye-law 3(2) of the Lobatsi General Bye-laws, 1967 (hereinafter referred to as the principal bye-laws) is amended by the insertion after "defecate" of "or urinate"

**Insertion of Bye-law 35A into S.I. No. 47 of 1967**

3. The principal bye-laws are amended by the insertion of the following bye-law after bye-law 35 —

**"Control of Air Guns and Catapults**

35A. (1) No person shall carry or discharge any air rifle, air pistol or catapult in any street or public place.

(2) No person shall discharge any air rifle or catapult, otherwise than in a street or public place, in a manner whereby the projectile so discharged would, or would be likely to, travel into any street or public place."

**Amendment of Bye-law 36 of S.I. No. 47 of 1967**

4. The principal bye-laws are amended in bye-law 36(2) by the deletion of "or 32" and the substitution of ", 32 or 35A".
