THE RULES OF PROCEDURE OF THE HOUSE OF CHIEFS (AMENDMENT) 1968

In exercise of the powers vested in them by section 84 of the Constitution, the House of Chiefs, with the approval of His Excellency the President, hereby makes the following rules –

Citation

1. These rules may be cited as the Rules of Procedure of the House of Chiefs (Amendment), 1968.

Amendment of Rule 17 of Legal Notice No. 27 of 1965

2. The Rules of Procedure of the House of Chiefs are amended in sub-rule (3) of Rule 17 by the deletion of "the Secretary seven" and the substitution of "reach the Secretary at least three clear".
