THE TRADE MARKS (TRANSFER OF POWERS) ORDER, 1968
(Published on 8th July, 1968)

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 22 of the Interpretation and General Provisions Law, 1968 (Law No. 13 of 1968), His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Order --

Citation

1. This Order may be cited as the Trade Marks (Transfer of Powers) Order, 1968.

Interpretation

1. In this Order --

(a) the word "law" means the Trade Marks Proclamation (Chapter 155);

(b) the word "Trade Marks" means the person appointed Registrar of Trade Marks for the purposes of the Interpretation of United Kingdom Trade Marks Proclamation (Chapter 154);

(c) the word "Registrar" means the Registrar of Trade Marks;

(d) the powers or duties vested in the President under sections 5, 22 and 25 of the principal law are hereby transferred to the Registrar of Trade Marks.

Transfer of Functions to the Minister.

4. The powers or duties vested in the President under sections 5, 22 and 25 of the principal law are hereby transferred to the Minister.
