**THE CHOBE NATIONAL PARK (KACHIKAU-KASANE ROAD TRAFFIC)  
REGULATIONS, 1971**

*(Published on the 13th August, 1971)*

In the exercise of the powers conferred by section 15 of the National Parks Act, 1967, the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs has made the following regulations —

| Citation  | <b>1.</b> These regulations may be cited as the Chobe National Park (Kachikau-Kasane Road Traffic) Regulations, 1971.  |
| Inter-pretation                                   | <b>2.</b> In these regulations, unless the context otherwise requires —<br>“the Park” means the Chobe National Park;<br>“the road” means the portion of the public road between Kachikau and Kasane, designated A 72 in Government Notice No. 5 of 1960, which traverses the Park by way of Ngoma and Serondela. |
| Use of Road by Motor Vehicles at Night Prohibited | <b>3.</b> No person shall drive, or cause to be driven, any motor vehicle on the road during the period between half an hour after sunset and half an hour before sunrise.   |
| Speed Limit on Road                               | <b>4.</b> No person shall drive any vehicle, or cause any vehicle to be driven or to move, on the road at a speed exceeding the rate of forty kilometres per hour.   |
| Penalty   | <b>5.</b> Any person who contravenes any provision of these regulations shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of R200 or, in default of payment, to imprisonment for six months.  |
