**CUSTOMS, EXCISE AND SALES DUTY (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS,
1971**

(Published on the 10th September, 1971)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 122 of the Customs, Excise and Sales Duty Act, 1970, I, Q.K.J. Masire, Minister of Finance and Development Planning hereby make the following regulations —

1. These regulations may be cited as the Customs, Excise and Sales Duty (Amendment) Regulations, 1971. Citation

2. The Customs, Excise and Sales Duty Regulations, 1971, are amended by the insertion, immediately after regulation 70, of the following new regulation — Insertion of new regulation into S.I. 100/71

Import and Export list **71.** The Director may, by notice in the Gazette, issue an Import and Export list of articles of merchandise showing the designations and code numbers by which they are to be distinguished, and the denominations (whether by weight, measure, value or otherwise) by which they are severally to be declared in the entries, and he may, by notice in the Gazette, make alterations or additions to or deletions from such list.”
