Citation **1.** This Notice may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (Amendment of Schedules) Notice, 1971.

Amendment of Second Schedule to Proc. 22 of 1961 **2.** (1) Part I of the Second Schedule to the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Proclamation) is amended in column 1 thereof by the addition in their correct alphabetical order of the following animals —

Black-footed Cat
Civet
Mountain Reedbuck
Night-Ape
Serval
Vaal Rhebok
Kgori Bustard
Stanley Bustard
All Eagles
All Egrets
All Flamingoes

(2) Part II of the Second Schedule is amended in the first column thereof by the addition, in its correct alphabetical order, of—

“Lion”

and by the deletion of—

“Aardwolf”.

3. The Third Schedule to the principal Proclamation is repealed and replaced by the following new Schedule—

GAME ANIMALS

Part A — *Game Birds* Ducks and Geese (excluding Pygmy Geese and Fulvous Tree Duck), Francolin, Guineafowl, Quail, Sandgrouse, Snipe, Green Pigeons and Turtle Doves.

To be hunted in unlimited numbers under a Bird Game Licence.

4. The Fourth Schedule to the principal Proclamation is repealed and replaced by the following new Schedule —

“FOURTH SCHEDULE
(sections 16 and 41)

Animals which may not be hunted by virtue of land-holder’s privilege and animals the destruction of which must be reported —

- Any conserved animal,
- Any protected game,
- Crocodile,
- Elephant,
- Leopard.”.

5. (1) The Fifth Schedule to the principal Proclamation is amended in the paragraph entitled “Package Licence” by the deletion of the words —

- “Package B R400.00
- Package C R300.00”.

Repeal and replacement of Fourth Schedule to the principal Proclamation

Amendment of Fifth Schedule to the principal Proclamation

(2) The Fifth Schedule to the principal Proclamation is further amended in the paragraph entitled "General Game Licence" by the deletion of the words —

"Non-Resident	7 days	R20.00

and the substitution therefor of the following words —

(3) The Fifth Schedule to the principal Proclamation is further amended by the deletion of the paragraph entitled "Commuted Export Duty" and the substitution therefor of the following new paragraph —

"Commuted Export Duty (Section 64)

Package	A	R50.00".

Repeal and replacement of Sixth Schedule to the principal Proclamation

6. The Sixth Schedule to the principal Proclamation is repealed and replaced by the following new Schedule —

Animals', tusks, horns, hides and skins of which must be delivered to the nearest District Officer, etc.

Any conserved animal,
Any protected game,
Crocodile,
Elephant,
Leopard."

7. The Eight Schedule to the principal Proclamation is repealed and replaced by the following new Schedule —
