FAUNA CONSERVATION PROCLAMATION, 1961 (22 OF 1961)

**FAUNA CONSERVATION (STATE LAND CONTROLLED HUNTING AREAS)  
(AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1971**

(Published on the 12th March, 1971)

In exercise of the powers conferred by section 11 of the Fauna Conservation Proclamation, 1961 the Minister of Commerce, Industry and Water Affairs has made the following regulations -

1. These regulations may be cited as the Fauna Conservation (State Land Controlled Hunting Areas) (Amendment) Regulations, 1971.

2. The Fourth Schedule to the Fauna Conservation (State Land Controlled Hunting Areas) Regulations, 1968 is amended -

(i) by the deletion of paragraph (a) thereof and the substitution thereof of the following new paragraph -

“(a) The following fees shall be paid by non-residents of the controlled hunting areas in which these regulations apply for permits to hunt in such areas -

Resident of Botswana	R10-00 for each 7-day period.
Non-Resident of Botswana	R50-00 for each 7-day period.”;

and

(ii) in paragraph (b) thereof by the deletion of subsubparagraph (ii) (d) and the substitution therefor of the following new subsubparagraph -

“(d) For Permit “A” for Okwa, Anderssen’s Vlei, Eastern Kgalagadi, Western Kgalagadi and Tshabong Controlled Hunting Areas -
