**FRANCISTOWN (ANNUAL) RATING BYE-LAWS, 1971**

*(Published on the 3rd September, 1971)*

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulation 31 of the Town Council Regulations, 1966 the Francistown Town Council has made the following bye-laws —

- Citation           **1.** These bye-laws may be cited as the Francistown (Annual) Rating Bye-Laws, 1971.
- Levy of rate       **2.** A rate of 2 cents in the rand in respect of land excluding improvements is levied on all rateable land within Francistown and Tatitown Townships in respect of the period 1st January to 31st December, 1971.
- When rate is due and payable   **3.** The rate fixed in bye-law 2 shall become due and payable by the owner on the 15th day of October, 1971.
