THE FRANCISTOWN GENERAL (AMENDMENT) BYE-LAWS, 1971

(Published on the 29th January, 1971)

In accordance with the powers vested in him by regulation 32 of the Town Council Regulations, 1966 (Legal Notice No. 37 of 1966), His Excellency the President has been pleased to approve of the following bye-laws made by the Francistown Town Council in the exercise of the powers vested in it by regulation 31 of the said regulations —

1. These bye-laws may be cited as the Francistown General (Amendment) Bye-Laws, 1970. Citation.
2. Bye-Law 1 of the Francistown General Bye-Laws contained in Statutory Instrument No. 41 of 1967 is amended by the deletion of "1966" and the substitution therefor of "1967". Amendment of Bye-Law 1 in Statutory Instrument No. 41 of 1967.
3. Bye-Law 6 of the Francistown General Bye-Laws, 1967, is amended by the insertion immediately after "Council" of "to reduce the danger of death by drowning and". Amendment of Bye-Law 6 in Statutory Instrument No. 41 of 1967.
