**THE TOWN COUNCIL REGULATIONS, 1966**

**GABORONE (SMOKING IN CINEMAS ETC.) BYE-LAWS, 1971**

*(Published on the 16th April, 1971)*

In the exercise of the powers vested in him by section 32 of the Town Council Regulations, 1966 (Legal Notice No. 37 of 1966), the Minister of Local Government and Lands has approved the following bye-laws made by the Gaborone Town Council —

**1.** These bye-laws may be cited as the Gaborone (Smoking in Cinemas Citation etc.) Bye-Laws, 1971.

**2.** (1) No person shall smoke tobacco or any other substance in a pipe or in the form of a cigar, cheroot, cigarillo or cigarette or in any other form or manner in any cinema, theatre, hall or roofed and enclosed place in which a public meeting, service, entertainment, recital or performance is being held, shown or given. Smoking in Cinemas etc. Prohibited

(2) This bye-law shall not apply to any performer while engaged in playing a part in any theatrical performance.

**3.** Any person who contravenes bye-law 2 shall be guilty of an offence and shall be liable on a first conviction to a fine of R10 or, in default of payment, imprisonment for a period of 14 days and on a subsequent conviction to a fine of R50 or, in default of payment, imprisonment for a period of 2 months.
