THE EDUCATION (FEES) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1972

Regulations made by the Minister of Education in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by sections 26 and 30 of the Education Law, 1966 and of all other powers thereunto him enabling

ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Amendment of regulation 6 of S.I. No. 8 of 1967
3. Repeal and replacement of regulation 9 of S.I. No. 8 of 1967

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Education (Fees) (Amendment) Regulations, 1972, and shall be read and construed as one with the Education (Fees) Regulations, 1967, hereinafter referred to as the principal Regulations.

Citation

2. Regulation 6 of the principal Regulations is amended as follows —

(i) by the deletion of the words "The Local Education Authority" wheresoever they appear in subregulation (1) thereof and by the substitution therefor of the words "The appropriate authority"; and

(ii) by the insertion therein immediately after subregulation (1) thereof of a new subregulation as follows —

“(1A) For the purposes of subregulation (1) "appropriate authority" shall mean —

(i) the Chief Education Officer where fees are receivable either by a person designated by him under regulation 9 or by the head of an aided school; and

(ii) the Local Education Authority where fees are receivable by it or by a person designated by it.”.

3. Regulation 9 of the principal Regulations is repealed and replaced by a new regulation as follows —

“To whom fees payable 9. (1) Fees shall be paid —

(i) in the case of a Government school to such person as may be designated by the Chief Education Officer as being the person to receive fees in respect of such school;

- (ii) in the case of a Local Government school to the Local Education Authority or to such person as may be designated by such Authority as being the person to receive fees in respect of such school:

Provided that where a Local Government school is managed by the Government and not by the Local Education Authority fees shall be paid to such person as may be designated by the Chief Education Officer;

- (iii) in the case of an aided school to the headmaster of such school.

(2) Receipts shall be issued by the persons receiving such fee and a duplicate kept at the school for a period of not less than three years.”.
