Order made by His Excellency the President in exercise of the powers conferred upon him by section 4 of the Diplomatic Immunities and Privileges Act, 1968, and of all other powers thereunto him enabling.

1. This Order may be cited as the Immunities and Privileges (Commonwealth Secretariat) Order, 1972. Citation

2. The Commonwealth Secretariat is declared to be an organisation of which Botswana and other foreign sovereign powers or the Governments thereof are members. Declaration

3. The Commonwealth Secretariat shall have the immunities and privileges set out in Part II of the Second Schedule of the Diplomatic Immunities and Privileges Act, 1968, and shall have the legal capacity of a body corporate. Conferment of immunities and privileges
