**MOTOR VEHICLE AND ROAD TRAFFIC (IMPOSITION OF SPEED
LIMITS) REGULATIONS, 1972**

(Published on the 14th January, 1972)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 34 of the Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic Proclamation, His Excellency the President has made the following regulations:

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic (Imposition of Speed Limits) Regulations, 1972. Citation
2. No person shall drive any motor vehicle upon any public road within the specially defined areas specified in the First Schedule hereto at a speed exceeding a limit of 50 kilometres per hour. Imposition of speed limits within certain areas
3. No person shall drive any motor vehicle upon any of the public roads specified in the Second Schedule hereto at a speed exceeding a limit of 80 kilometres per hour. Imposition of speed limit on certain public roads
4. The Motor Vehicle and Road Traffic (Imposition of Speed Limits) Regulations, 1971, are revoked. Revocation of S.I. 5/1971

FIRST SCHEDULE

1. The Gaborone Township as defined from time to time in terms of section 1 of the Townships Proclamation (Chapter 120).
2. The Francistown Township as defined from time to time in terms of section 1 of the Townships Proclamation (Chapter 120).
3. The Ghanzi Township as defined by High Commissioner's Notice No. 27 of 1960.
4. The area within a radius of two miles from the Post Office at Kanye in the Ngwaketse District.

5. The area within a radius of two miles from the Post Office at Lobatse in the Lobatse District.
6. The area within a radius of two miles from the Post Office at Mahalapye in the Ngwato District.
7. The area within a radius of two miles from the District Commissioner's Office at Maun in the Ngamiland District.
8. The area within a radius of three miles from the Tribal Office at Mochudi in the Kgatleng District.
9. The area within a radius of three miles from the Post Office at Molepolole in the Kweneng District.
10. The area within a radius of two miles from the Railway Station at Palapye in the Ngwato District.
11. The area within a radius of three miles from the Post Office at Serowe in the Ngwato District.
12. The area within a radius of three miles from the Post Office at Tonota in the Ngwato District.
13. The area within a radius of three miles from the Police Station at Ramotswa.
14. The Selebi-Pikwe Township as defined from time to time in terms of section 1 of the Townships Proclamation (Chapter 120).

SECOND SCHEDULE

That portion of the public road between Seruli and Selebi-Pikwe as lies between the turn-off to Selebi-Pikwe from the main Gaborone/Francistown
