ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES AND SERVICES ACT, 1973
(22 of 1973)

ESSENTIAL SUPPLIES (PETROL) (AMENDMENT) REGULATIONS, 1973

(Published on the 29th November, 1973)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Supplies and Services Act, 1973, His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Essential Supplies (Petrol) Citation (Amendment) Regulations, 1973.

2. Regulation 3 of the Essential Supplies (Petrol) Regulations, 1973, hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations", is amended by substituting for subregulation (1) thereof the following new subregulation —

"(1) No re-seller of petrol with premises situate within the areas specified in the Schedule shall sell or in any other way whatsoever dispose of petrol in his possession or under his control other than on the following days and between the following hours —

(a) on Mondays to Fridays inclusive, between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m; and

(b) on Saturdays, between the hours of 6 a.m. and 1 p.m."

3. Regulation 7 of the principal Regulations is amended —

(a) by substituting for subregulation (1) thereof the following new subregulation —

"(1) Except under and in accordance with the conditions of a permit, no person shall use or permit to be used aviation fuel to fly any aircraft except for the purpose of a charter flight or a scheduled flight:

Provided that this subregulation shall not apply to Wenela Air Services."

(b) by inserting, immediately after subregulation (6) thereof, the following new subregulation —

"(6A) No person shall sell or in any other way dispose of any aviation fuel in his possession or under his control within Gaborone or Francistown, the boundaries of which are as defined under the Townships Proclamation, except under and in accordance with the provisions of a permit:

Provided that this subregulation shall not apply to the sale or supply of aviation fuel to any person operating a scheduled flight from Gaborone or Francistown airfields for use during that flight."

Substitution
of Schedule

4. The principal Regulations are amended by substituting for the Schedule thereto the following new Schedule —

SCHEDULE (reg. 3)

1. The area within 80 kilometres of the railway line running between Ramatlabama and Vakaranga.

2. The area within 80 kilometres of the railway line running between Serule and Selebi-Pikwe.”.
