ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAWS

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulation 31 read with regulation 32 of the Town Council Regulations, 1966, the Francistown Town Council has, with the approval of the Minister of Local Government and Lands, made the following Bye-Laws-

- Citation **1.** These Bye-laws may be cited as the Francistown General (Amendment) Bye-laws, 1973.
- Amendment of bye-law 8 of Francistown Bye-laws, 1967 **2.** Bye-law 8 of the Francistown Bye-laws, 1967 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Bye-laws), is amended by substituting for paragraph (1) thereof the following new paragraph —
 “(1) No person shall keep or graze any livestock within the Township without the written consent of the Council.”
- Amendment of bye-law 34 **3.** (a) Bye-law 34 of the principal Bye-laws is amended by inserting immediately after the word “neighbourhood” which occurs in paragraph (a) thereof the following —
 “or which any authorized Council Official or police officer of or above the rank of sergeant considers to be causing annoyance or unnecessary noise in any part of the Township”.
(b) Paragraph (b) of bye-law 34 is amended by inserting immediately after the word “Council” the following words —
 “in writing and subject to such conditions as the Council may impose”.
