ENACTED by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Judges (Salaries and Allowances) (Amendment) Act, 1974, and shall be deemed to have come into operation on 1st April, 1974.

2. Section 3 (1) of the Judges (Salaries and Allowances) Act, 1968, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Act"), is amended by substituting for the words "R330", which appear therein, the words "R1 200".

3. Section 4 of the principal Act is amended —
(a) by substituting for the words "R6 810", which appear in paragraph (a) thereof, the words "R7 704" ; and

(b) by substituting for the words “an allowance of R1 362 a year”, which appear in paragraph (b) thereof, the words “an annual allowance calculated at the rate of 20 per centum of the salary payable under paragraph (a)”.

4. Section 5 of the principal Act is amended —

(a) by substituting for the words “R6 030”, which appear in paragraph (a) thereof, the words “R7 032” ; and

(b) by substituting for the words “an allowance of R1 206 a year”, which appear in paragraph (b) thereof, the words “an annual allowance calculated at the rate of 20 per centum of the salary payable under paragraph (a)”.

Schedule

5. The First Schedule to the principal Act is amended by substituting for paragraph 1 thereof the following new paragraph —

“1. The gratuity shall be twenty-five per centum for the first period of a judge’s service, twenty-seven and one-half per centum for the second period, and thirty per centum for all such subsequent periods, of the amounts payable under the provisions of section 4 (a) and (b) or section 5 (a) and (b) from the date when the functions of the office were assumed or when the last gratuity occurred (whichever is the later) to the date upon which the gratuity accrues, or next accrues, under the provisions of this Schedule.”.
