ARRANGEMENT OF BYE-LAWS

BYE-LAW

1. Citation
2. Levy of rates
3. When rates due and payable

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by regulation 30 as read with regulation 31 of the Town Council Regulations, the Selebi-Phikwe Town Council, with the approval of the Minister of Local Government and Lands, hereby makes the following Bye-laws –

1. These Bye-laws may be cited as the Selebi-Phikwe (1976/77) Rating Bye-laws, 1976. Citation
2. The following rates are levied in respect of the period 1st April, 1976, to 31st March, 1977 – Levy of rates
 - (a) a rate of 2,50 thebe in the pula in respect of all improved rateable land with the Selebi-Phikwe Township; or
 - (b) in respect of unimproved rateable land with the Selebi-Phikwe Township –
 - (i) where a person liable to pay rates has held such land for any period of four years or more, a rate of 12,50 thebe in the pula; and
 - (ii) where the person liable to pay rates has held such land for any period of less than four years, a rate of 5,00 thebe in the pula:

Provided that where, in respect of any improved rateable land, the rates calculated in accordance with the foregoing are less than would be payable if such land were not improved, the rate in respect of such land shall be calculated as if such land were unimproved.
3. The rates fixed in bye-law 2 shall become due and payable by the person liable to pay rates on 31st December, 1976. When rates due and payable
