**SCHEDULE**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Home Affairs by section 104 of the Employment Act, the following Order is hereby made –

1. This Order may be cited as the Employment (Declaration of Labour Health Areas) (No. 2) Order, 1979. Citation
2. Every area specified in the Schedule is declared to be a labour health area for the purposes of the Act. Declaration of labour health areas
3. Sections 105, 107 and 108 of the Act shall apply to each of the labour health areas declared by paragraph 2. Application of certain provisions of Act to labour health areas declared by paragraph 2

**SCHEDULE**

(para. 2)

**LABOUR HEALTH AREAS**

Any area in which employees are, for the time being, engaged under their contracts of service on work directly connected with –

- (a) the construction of the new main road from Lobatse to Kanye;
- (b) the construction of the new main road from Kanye to Jwaneng;
- (c) the construction of the new main road from Mahalapye to Serule; or
- (d) the sinking of the No. 3 shaft within the mining area at Selebi-Phikwe.
