REGULATION

1. Citation

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Supplies and Services Act, 1973, His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Essential Supplies (Petrol) Citation (Extension of Hours of Sale) Regulations, 1979.

2. In these Regulations —
“petrol” includes any mixture of petrol with any other substance capable of being used as a fuel in internal combustion engines;
“re-seller of petrol” means a person who operates premises in respect of which a petrol filling station licence has been issued under the Trading Act.

3. In addition to the hours specified in regulation 3 (1) of the Essential Supplies (Petrol) Regulations, 1979, a re-seller of petrol with premises situated within Gaborone Township may sell petrol at, in or from those premises between the hours 6 a.m. and 1 p.m. on Sunday, 13th May, 1979.
