ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Interpretation
3. Speed limit
4. Penalty

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 3 of the Essential Supplies and Services Act, 1973, His Excellency the President hereby makes the following Regulations –

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Essential Supplies (Speed Limit) Regulations, 1979. Citation
2. In these Regulations – Interpretation
“motor vehicle” has the same meaning as in the Road Traffic Act;
“road” has the same meaning as in the Road Traffic Act. Cap. 69:01
3. Without prejudice to the Road Traffic (Speed Limits for Specified Vehicles) Regulations, no person shall drive or permit to be driven any motor vehicle upon a road at a speed greater than 90 km per hour. Speed limit
Cap. 69:01
(Sub. Leg.)
4. Any person who contravenes regulation 3 shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of P2 000 and to imprisonment for one year. Penalty
