ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation
2. Amendment of Schedule Cap. 40:02 (Sub. Leg.)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Local Government and Lands by section 2 of the Townships Act, the following Order is hereby made –

1. This Order may be cited as the Declaration of Townships Citation (Amendment) Order, 1981.

2. The Schedule to the Declaration of Townships Order is hereby amended by substituting for paragraph 4 thereof the following new paragraph –

"4. LOBATSE TOWNSHIP

The boundary of the township is as follows –

Commencing at the northwestern beacon of Lot 1, Lobatse, the boundary runs generally southeastwards along the northern boundary of the said Lot 1, Lobatse, to the northeastern beacon thereof, being a beacon on the western boundary of the Railway Reserve No. 7-JO; thence southeastwards in a straight line to the beacon lettered "K" on Diagram D.S.L. No. 4065/26, being a beacon on the western boundary of Portion 2 (Goede Hoop) of the farm Woodhall No. 11-JO; thence generally southwards along the western boundaries of the said Portion 2 (Goede Hoop) and Portion 3 (Christina) of the farm Woodhall No. 11-JO to the northwestern beacon of Lot 820, Lobatse, (formerly Portion 4 (Mooihoek) of the farm Woodhall No. 11-JO), lettered "A" on Diagram D.S.L. 4067/26; thence eastwards and southwards along the northern and eastern boundaries of the said Lot 820, Lobatse, to the southernmost beacon thereof, being a beacon on the northwestern boundary of Portion 5 (Weeskind) of the farm Woodhall No. 11-JO; thence generally southwestwards and southeastwards along the northwestern and southwestern boundaries of the said Portion 5 to the point where the latter boundary is intersected by the southern boundary of Lot 1071, Lobatse, which point being the easternmost beacon of the said Lot 1071, Lobatse; thence generally southwestwards along the southern boundary of the said Lot 1071, Lobatse, to the southernmost beacon thereof; thence southwestwards in a straight line to the beacon lettered "G" on Diagram D.S.L. No. 56/74, being a beacon on the northeastern boundary of Lot 1735, Lobatse; thence generally southeastwards, southwestwards and northwestwards along the eastern, southern and southwestern boundaries of the said Lot 1735, Lobatse, to the common beacon to the said Lot 1735, Lobatse, the remainder of the farm Springfield No. 18-JO and Lot 333, Lobatse; thence generally southwards along the eastern boundaries of Lots 333, 620 and 330, Lobatse, the southeastern boundaries of Lots 330, 620 and 329, Lobatse, and the southwestern boundary of Lot 329, Lobatse, to the westernmost beacon of the latter, being a beacon on the eastern boundary of the Railway Reserve No. 7-JO; thence in a straight line to the southernmost beacon of Lot 322, Lobatse, being a

beacon on the western boundary of the Railway Reserve No. 7-JO; thence generally northwards along the western boundaries of the said Lot 322, Lobatse, the southern, western and northern boundaries of Lot 321, Lobatse, and the western boundary of Lot 164, Lobatse, to the point where the latter boundary intersects the southern boundary of Lot 1, Lobatse; thence generally westwards and northwards along the southern and western boundaries of the said Lot 1, Lobatse, to the point of commencement, as will more fully appear on Plan No. JO-109a deposited with the Director of Surveys and Lands, Gaborone."
