1. Citation

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on His Excellency the President by section 3 of the Essential Supplies and Services Act, the following Regulations are hereby made

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Essential supplies (Petrol) Citation
(Extension of Hours of Sale) Regulations, 1981.

2. These Regulations shall be read and construed as one with the Essential Supplies (Petrol) Regulations, 1979, (hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations"). Interpretation

3. Notwithstanding regulation 3 (1) of the Regulations, a re-seller of petrol with premises situated within Gaborone Township may sell petrol at, in or from those premises between 7.00 a.m. and 6.00 p.m. on Sunday, 7th June, 1981. Extension of hours
