**SCHEDULE**

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Works and Communications by section 4 of the Civil Aviation Act, the following Order is hereby made —

| 1. This Order may be cited as the New Gaborone Airport (Controlled Area) (No. 2) Order, 1982.   | Citation  |
| 2. The area of land specified in the Schedule is hereby declared to be subject to control for the purposes of the Act.  | Declaration of controlled area  |
| 3. Every private right of way over or entry to the area of land specified in the Schedule or any part thereof is hereby extinguished.   | Extinguishment of private rights of way over and entry to controlled area |
| 4. (1) No person shall enter or, having entered, remain on the area of land specified in the Schedule or any part thereof unless he then has a lawful right to do so.<br>(2) Any person who contravenes this paragraph shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine of P500 and to imprisonment for 6 months.<br>(3) In any proceedings for an offence under this paragraph or for attempting or conspiring with another person to commit such an offence, the court shall presume that no person accused in the proceedings had, at any time, a lawful right to enter or remain on the area of land specified in the Schedule or any part thereof unless the contrary is proved. | Prohibition of entry to and remaining on controlled area                  |
| 5. The New Gaborone Airport (Controlled Area) Order, 1982, is hereby revoked.   | Revocation of S.I. 62 of 1982   |
