### SCHEDULE

**An Act to authorize the payment out of the Consolidated Fund and the Development Fund of sums of money for the year ending 31st March, 1985.**

*Date of Assent: 27.3.84*

*Date of Commencement: 30.3.84*

**ENACTED** by the Parliament of Botswana.

1. This Act may be cited as the Appropriation (1984/85) Act, 1984. Short title
2. The Minister of Finance and Development Planning may issue a warrant for the payment from the Consolidated Fund for the year ending 31st March, 1985, of the sum of P559 878 190 (five hundred and fifty-nine million, eight hundred and seventy-eight thousand one hundred and ninety pula). Expenditure from Consolidated Fund
3. The sum authorized by section 2 is appropriated to and shall be applied for purposes of the Heads of Expenditure set out in the first and second columns of the schedule, in the amounts set out in the corresponding entries in the third column of the Schedule. 4. The Minister of Finance and Development Planning may issue a warrant for the payment from the Development Fund for the year ending 31st March, 1985, of the sum of P238 184 000 (two hundred and thirty-eight million, one hundred and eighty-four thousand pula).

5. The sum authorized by section 4, being the total amount necessary to meet expenditure on all projects for which provision has been made in the annual estimates of the Development Fund for the financial year ending 31st March, 1985, approved by the National Assembly, is appropriated and shall be applied to meet that expenditure
