ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Special provision for domestic employees

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Home Affairs by section 104 of the Employment Act, 1982, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Employment (Domestic Employees) Regulations, 1984. Citation

2. In the case of a domestic employee, —

- (a) section 93 of the Act shall not apply;
- (b) section 96 of the Act shall not apply;

Provided that a domestic employee shall not be required under his contract of employment to work more than 240 hours in any one period of 4 weeks;

- (c) section 100 of the Act shall apply as if the public holidays specified in the Second Schedule the Act were News Year's Day, Good Friday, Botswana Day and Christmas Day alone; and
- (c) Parts V, IX, XIV and XV of the Act shall not apply, except as otherwise prescribed.
