ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Interpretation
3. Extension of hours of sale of petrol in respect of Scheduled premises

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President by section 3 of the Essential Supplies and Services Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Essential Supplies (Petrol) (Extension of Hours of Sale) Regulations, 1984, and shall be deemed to have come into effect on the 18th April, 1984. Citation

2. These Regulations shall be read and construed as one with the Essential Supplies (Petrol) Regulations, 1982, (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Regulations"). Interpre-

3. From Wednesday, 18th April, 1984, to Wednesday, 25th April, 1984, a re-seller of petrol with Scheduled premises may, notwithstanding regulation 3 of the principal Regulations, sell petrol, at, in or from those premises between 6 a.m. to 8 p.m. on any day. Extension
