IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President by section 19 of the Tribal Land Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Establishment of Subordinate Land Boards (Amendment) (No. 2) Order, 1984. Citation

2. The Establishment of Subordinate Land Boards Order, 1973, is hereby amended by substituting for paragraph 4 thereof the following new paragraph — Substitution

^{“Com} 4. Each Subordinate Land Board shall consist of 7 members S.I. 47 of

Land Boards</sub> comprising —

- (a) one member being a sub-chief appointed by the Minister from among the sub-chiefs of the villages in the area of jurisdiction of the Subordinate Land Board or that sub-chief's representative;
- (b) 3 members being representatives of the tribe appointed by the Minister from a slate of 6 persons elected publicly at the kgotla;
- (c) one member being the representative of the District Council;
- (d) one member being the representative of the Minister for the time being responsible for agriculture;
- (e) one member being the representative of the Minister for the time being responsible for commerce and industry, who may take part in the proceedings of a meeting of the Subordinate Land Board only to the extent that the proceedings are in respect of a matter relating to commerce or industry:

Provided that no such member shall vote on any question before a meeting of the Subordinate Land Board.”.
