**REGULATION OF WAGES (WHOLESALE AND RETAIL
DISTRIBUTIVE TRADES) (AMENDMENT) ORDER, 1984**

(Published on 1st June, 1984)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Home Affairs by section 8 of the Regulation of Wages and Conditions of Employment Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Regulation of Wages (Wholesale and Retail Distributive Trades) (Amendment) Order, 1984. Citation

2. The Regulation of Wages (Wholesale and Retail Distributive Trades) Order, 1980 is hereby amended in paragraph 3 thereof by substituting for the provisions immediately preceding the proviso to the said paragraph, the following two sub-paragraphs — Amendment
of
paragraph 3
of S.I. No.
107 of 1980

“(1) There shall be paid to employees in the Wholesale Distributive Trade a basic minimum wage of 47t per hour and 35t per hour for unskilled employees and night-watchmen respectively.

“(2) Employees in the Retail Distributive Trade shall be paid a basic minimum wage of 46t per hour except that persons employed by the undertaking to watch over any property of the Industry shall be paid a basic minimum wage of 35t per hour.”
