ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation
2. Appointment of general registration
3. Designated polling districts
4. Duties of registration officers

WHEREAS by virtue of orders made by the President a general registration period has been appointed in respect of each of the constituencies specified in the Schedule hereto;

And whereas by Government Notice No. 153 of 1984 new polling stations have been established in certain polling districts in the said constituencies;

And whereas the President considers that it is necessary for new general rolls to be prepared in order to obtain accurate rolls of voters in each of the said constituencies;

NOW THEREFORE, in exercise of the powers conferred on the President by section 7 (1) of the Electoral Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Voters (General Registration Period) (No. 4) Order, 1984. Citation
2. The period from 14th May, 1984 to 18th May, 1984, both dates inclusive, is hereby appointed to be a general registration period in respect of the constituencies specified in the Schedule. Appointment of general registration
3. The polling districts appointed in each of the said constituencies (other than the polling districts in which new polling stations have been established by Government Notice No. 153 of 1984) are hereby designated as districts in which the relevant sections of the existing rolls shall be used in the preparation of general rolls following that general registration period. Designated polling Districts
4. During the general registration period hereby appointed registration officers shall attend at all polling stations (other than designated polling districts) in each of the said constituencies for registering voters. Duties of registration officers
