Bye-Law 1 of Jwaneng Town Council (Control of Dogs) Bye-Laws 1985 (hereinafter referred to as "the principal Bye-Laws") is hereby amended by substituting for the words "Jwaneng (Control of Dogs) Bye-Laws, 1985" the words "Jwaneng Town Council (Control of Dogs) Bye-Laws, 1985". |
| Amendment of bye-law 2 of principal Bye-Laws | 3. Bye-Law 2 of the principal Bye-Laws is hereby amended. —
(a) by deleting the definition of the word "public places";
(b) by inserting therein immediately before the definition of the words "dog", the following new definition:—
" 'council area' means the area under the jurisdiction of the council;" |
