DECLARATION OF RABIES (NGAMILAND, NORTH EAST, KGATLENG
AND JWANENG) INFECTED AREAS ORDER, 1986
(Published on 25th July, 1986)

ARRANGEMENT OF PARAGRAPHS

PARAGRAPH

1. Citation
2. Declaration of infected areas
3. Inoculation of dogs in infected areas
4. Isolation of infected dogs
5. Destruction of dogs not kept in isolation
6. Restriction as to movement of dogs in infected areas

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Director of Veterinary Services by section 4 of the Diseases of Animals Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the Declaration of Rabies (Ngamiland, North East, Kgatleng and Jwaneng) Infected Areas Order, 1986.

2. The following areas are hereby declared to be infected with rabies —

- (a) Zone 2 (Ngamiland District) and Zone 6 (North East District) of the Veterinary Disease Control Zones as described in plan BP-223 which plan is deposited with the Director of Surveys and Lands;
- (b) the Kgatleng District;
- (c) Jwaneng Township and surrounding areas up to 10 kilometres radius from the Jwaneng post office.

3. The owner or any person in charge of a dog of or above the apparent age of 4 months shall, within 21 days, of the coming into operation of this Order ensure that such dog is inoculated against rabies by or under the supervision of a veterinary officer:

Provided that the provisions of this paragraph shall not apply to a dog which has been inoculated within 60 days immediately before the coming into operation of this Order.

4. The owner or any person in charge of a dog in an infected area shall ensure that such dog is isolated from other dogs by being kept at all times, either confined within a building or other enclosed premises or on a lead.

5. Any dog which has not been isolated in accordance with the provisions of paragraph 4 shall be deemed to have been in contact with or exposed to the disease of rabies and shall be destroyed in accordance with the provisions of section 12 of the Act.

6. No person shall without the permission of the Director of Veterinary Services or his representative, move any dog into or out of the infected area.
