ARRANGEMENT OF REGULATIONS

REGULATION

1. Citation
2. Amendment of regulation 80 of Cap. 69:01 (Sub. Leg)
3. Insertion of new Part XIII in principal Regulations

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the Minister of Works and Communications by section 127 of the Road Traffic Act, the following Regulations are hereby made —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Road Traffic (Amendment) Regulations, 1986. Citation

2. The Road Traffic Regulations (hereinafter referred to as the "principal Regulations") are hereby amended in regulation 80 thereof by substituting for the words "20 m" which appear in paragraph (e) thereof, the words "22 m." Amendment of regulation 80 of Cap. 69:01 (Sub. Leg)

3. The principal Regulations are hereby amended by inserting immediately after Part XII thereof the following new Part — Insertion of new Part XIII in principal Regulations

"PART XIII

Miscellaneous Provisions

139. No person shall, on a Friday, Saturday, or Sunday, the day preceeding a public holiday, or on a public holiday, drive or cause to be driven between the hours of 6 p.m. and midnight, a motor vehicle which exceeds 10,5 m in length along any of the roads specified in the following Table — Restriction on Movement of certain vehicles at night

Tlokweng border Gate — Gaborone road
Pioneer Gate — Lobatse road
Francistown — Nata — Kazungula road
Ramatlabama — Ramakgwebana road
Mahalapye — Parris Halt road
Martin's Drift — Palapye road
Serule — Selebi-Phikwe road"
