CUSTOMS AND EXCISE DUTY (AMENDMENT)
REGULATIONS, 1993
(Published on 2nd April, 1993)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 127 of the Customs and Excise Duty Act, the Vice-President and Minister of Finance and Economic Development hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Customs and Excise Duty (Amendment) Regulations, 1993. Citation

2. Regulation 75 (2) of the Customs and Excise Duty Act is amended by substituting for paragraphs (b) and (c) thereof the following new paragraphs — Amendment of regulation 75 (2)
“(b) at the following appointed airports, as indicated — Cap.50:01

3. Regulation 76 of the Regulations is amended —
- (a) in subregulation (7), by substituting for the figure and word “50 thebe” the figure and word “1 Pula”;
 - (b) by substituting for subregulation (8) the following new subregulation—
“(8) The charges for extra or special attendance, except when such attendance is given in respect of any service mentioned in subregulation (7), shall be 10 Pula per officer per hour or part thereof:
Provided that where such extra or special attendance is at an airport at which no resident customs officer is stationed, and where less than 12 hours notice of the arrival or departure of the aircraft concerned is given, there shall be an additional charge of 20 Pula, unless the proper officer, in special circumstances, decides otherwise.”; and
 - (c) by deleting subregulation (9) thereof
