| Citation | 1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence Force (Regular Force) (Cadet Officers) (Amendment) Regulations, 1993. |
| Amendment of regulation 7 (b) | 2. Regulation 7 (b) of the Defence Force (Regular Force) (Cadet Officers) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as "the Regulations", is amended by substituting for "the rate of P2 per day" the words "such rate as the Defence Council may determine". |
| Replacement of regulation 8 | 3. The Regulations are amended by substituting for regulation 8 thereof the following regulation — |
| "Subsistence allowance whilst attending selection board | 8. Whilst a candidate is attending an interview by the Selection Board at the place appointed, he shall be paid a subsistence allowance at such rate as may be determined by the Defence Council." |
| Amendment of regulation 9 | 4. Regulation 9 of the Regulations is amended by substituting for subregulation (1) thereof the following new subregulation —
“(1) Upon appointment as a cadet officer, the cadet officer shall be paid at such rate as may be determined by the Defence Council:
Provided that where the cadet officer is a graduate of a recognized university the rate determined by the Defence Council may be increased accordingly.” |
| Amendment of regulation 11 | 5. Regulation 11 of the Regulations is amended by inserting immediately after the word "Commander" the words "or an officer so authorized by the Commander". |
