IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 178 of the Botswana Defence Force Act, the President hereby makes the following Regulations —

1. These Regulations may be cited as the Defence Force (Summary Jurisdiction) (Amendment) Regulations, 1993. Citation
2. Regulation 2 of the Defence Force (Summary Jurisdiction) Regulations, hereinafter referred to as “the Regulations”, is amended by substituting for the definition of “subordinate commander” the following definition — Amendment of regulation 2
“subordinate commander” means the officer commanding a squadron, a battery, a company or an equivalent sub-unit, or an officer appointed by a commanding officer to be a subordinate commander:
Provided that any such appointment may —
 - (i) be made subject to such restrictions, reservations, exceptions or conditions as the commanding officer considers necessary or desirable;
 - (ii) designate the officer appointed, by name, or by office held or by reference to a class of officers, in which case such reference shall include any officer for the time being acting in or performing the functions of such office or acting in the place of such class;
 - (iii) be made in relation to a particular person, or any class or group of persons, or for a particular case or class of cases; or
 - (iv) be revoked, either wholly or in part by the commanding officer who made it, or by his successor.”
3. Regulation 6 of the Regulations is amended by deleting therefrom the words and brackets “(where the subject matter does not exceed in value P200)” wherever they may occur. Amendment of regulation 6
4. Regulation 7 (b) of the Regulations is amended by substituting for “P200” the words “the equivalent of seven days of the offender’s pay”. Amendment of regulation 7 (b)

5. Regulation 11 (2) of the Regulations is amended —
- (a) in paragraphs (a) and (c) by substituting for the word “seven” wherever it appears the word “fourteen” in each case; and
 - (b) in paragraph (b) by substituting for “P25” the words “the equivalent of four days pay”.

6. Regulation 12 of the Regulations is amended by —
- (a) deleting the brackets and words “(where the subject matter does not exceed in value P400)”;
and
 - (b) substituting “48” for “48 (c)”.

7. Regulation 13 of the Regulations is amended by substituting “the equivalent of ten days pay” for “P100”.

Amendment
of Schedule

8. Item 1 of the Schedule to the Regulations is amended by substituting “P2000” for “P400”.
