IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred on the President by section 7 (1) of the Electoral Act, the following Order is hereby made —

1. This Order may be cited as the General Registration Period Order, 1993. Citation
2. The general registration of voters for the 1994 General Elections shall commence on the 9th August, 1993 and terminate on 22nd August, 1993 between 7.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on each day of the said registration period in the constituencies specified in this Order. General registration period
