IMMIGRATION (EXEMPTION) ORDER, 1993
(Published on 19th February, 1993)

IN EXERCISE of the powers conferred by section 23 of the Immigration Act, the Minister of Labour and Home Affairs has made the following Order —

- Citation 1. This Order may be cited as the Immigration (Exemption) Order, 1993.
- Exemptions 2. The expatriate doctors and nurses employed by the undermentioned hospitals are hereby exempted from obtaining residence permits in order to reside in Botswana, for so long as they remain so employed, and provided that they are in possession of valid passports or certificates of identity —
- Bamalete Lutheran Hospital;
 - Bamangwato Concessions Ltd. Mine Hospital;
 - Deborah Retief Hospital;
 - Gaborone Private Hospital;
 - Jwaneng Mine Hospital;
 - Orapa Hospital;
 - Seventh Day Adventist Hospital, Kanye.
